Ref.: Information regarding entry

Dear Partner!

We would like to inform you that the location of our warehouse (H-1089 Budapest, Golgota u 4.) belongs to a restricted traffic zone, therefore the approach with a truck requires an entry permit with the exception of certain time periods and routes.

With our current letter we would like to help you in the registration for the required permit as well and inform you about the periods and special routes that are free of charge to approach our warehouse.

According to the council regulation Nr. 80/2008 (XII.30) the trucks of bigger than 7,5t grossweight are allowed to move on the restricted routes only with valid entry permission between 7,00am - 18,00 and 18,00-05,00am.

In the periods inbetween (5,00am – 7,00am and 18,00-22,00) our site is approachable without entry permission as well.

However please note, that in the sections of the Könyves Kálmán Krt and Hungária Krt in these periods still the 12t restriction is valid. The sections of the Könyves Kálmán Krt and Hungária Krt can be avoided by choosing any of the following routes:

- arriving from the direction of motorway M3: M31 (exit at Gödöllő towards M0) „Green route” (see point 2.),
- arriving from the direction of motorway M5: Gyáli út – Nagyvárad tér – Orczy út.
- arriving from the direction of Rákóczi híd (Lágymányosi híd): Mester utca – Haller utca – Orczy út

You have a possibility to approach our site at any time of the day without permission by choosing the following route:

„GREEN ROUTE”

Motorway M0 – Highway Nr.4 – Gyömrői út (not part of the Express way) – level crossing at Kőrös utca – Szállás utca – Kőbányai út.

Passing through the gate of Kőbányai út 25 please turn to the left then keep moving straight ahead and at the end of the street you can find our company's site.

Please note that through the gate from Delej street, drive-in is not possible. By car you can enter from 46 Orczy street, but by truck only from Kőbányai street, No. 25gate.

In cases apart from the periods and routes described in points 1. and 2. you have to have an entry permit.

As of January an on-line application system has been introduced, through which the administration will be quicker and more efficient, and the paper-based administration has been ceased.

The entry permit can be issued only according to application and after payment of registration fee and entry charges.

The applicants can register on the web-site: <http://tobi.bkk.hu> and also here you can pay the fees and charges electronically.

The registration fee is HUF 2000,00+ VAT/plate number at the moment. The applicants have to pay the data processing fee once, at the registration of a plate number.

At the registration the applicant can submit for which period he requests the permit (e.g. one day, one week, one year) then the payable entry fee will be calculated based on the data of the truck and the length of the requested period.

The fee of the entry permit will be paid electronically and the applicant receives a verification of it. After a few minutes' process the entry permit becomes usable immediately. (The truck drivers do not have to hold any proving documents with themselves).
